

2024 Tire Infraction Policy

Revised Jan 11, 2024

Chemically treating a tire is not permitted. Tires may be checked by track officials at any time. Samples can be taken during any practice, qualifying, and/or feature event.

Blue Ridge Race Labs is the trusted lab responsible for tire analysis. If tire samples taken for analysis do not meet manufacturer benchmarks, the team will be fined and disqualified from the event in which the sample was taken.

In addition to the fine, the driver and car owner are responsible for any fees associated with the tire analysis. In the event purse money had been collected by the team prior to official lab results, money awarded for the event of the infraction must be returned. In addition, the driver will be disqualified from the event and 0 points will be awarded.

Failure to allow samples to be taken will result in the same penalty as if a sample was taken and lab results did not meet manufacturer benchmarks, thus a disqualification from the event, 0 points awarded for the event, as well as the appropriate fine listed below.

Blue Ridge Lab Results will be official; OFFICIAL RESULTS ARE FINAL. All fines must be paid prior to the driver's return to competition.

Riverhead Raceway has a zero-tolerance policy for chemical treatment and/or alteration of tires.
