

2009 DEMOLITION DERBY RULES & REGULATIONS

DRIVER'S ENTRY:

1. All drivers must be 18 years of age or have a notarized minor's release submitted with the proper application (subject to approval of track steward).
2. All drivers must wear approved helmets (no shortie helmets), long pants and long sleeve shirts. A fire suit is recommended.
3. The use of any alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs prior to competing will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule may be grounds for suspension and ejection from the facility.

DRIVER'S RULES:

1. Driver must have car at the track before 7:00 PM. Cars arriving after the cut off time will not be allowed to compete unless prior arrangements have been made with the management.
2. No head-on collisions and NO DRIVERS DOOR hits.
3. The use of radios, cell phones and walkie-talkies is prohibited (subject to disqualification).
4. You have 30 seconds to hit another competitor. No teamwork or playing possum, this will be grounds for disqualification (subject to the official in charge).
5. All persons signing the release sheet will be covered by competitors insurance as follows:
 - a. \$5,000 Death
 - b. \$5,000 Dismemberment
 - c. \$5,000 Medical
 - d. \$40.00 per week, up to 26 weeks, after 8th day, if unable to work at regular job. All injuries must be reported to ambulance crew at once. NO EXCEPTIONS!
6. Attention must be paid to flagmen and track officials at all times.

7. Winning car may be checked for violations. Official's decision is final.
8. If your car does not pass inspection or you are unwilling to make changes to comply with inspections, there will be no refunds.
9. Proper I.D. must be shown when coming to the pay-off window.

CAR SPECIFICATIONS AND SAFETY RULES:

1. The use of anti-freeze is strictly prohibited and is cause for disqualification. A twenty-five dollar fine will be charged if anti-freeze is found during inspection.
2. The 8 Cylinder Division is open to any 1982 or newer American made unibody hard top passenger car (no compacts). Compacts and foreign cars are allowed in the 4/6 Cylinder Demolition Derby.
3. All cars must remain stock unless modification is stated in the rules.
4. Car must be completely gutted with the exception of the drivers seat and all glass must be removed with the exception of the windshield. Windshield may be replaced with cyclone or chain link fence. Broken glass in doors and/or tailgate must be removed before arriving at the track. Drivers using fence rather than a windshield must have a face shield on helmet.
5. Seat belts in proper working order are required and must be used at all times.
6. Driver's door must be painted a bright contrasting color (different than car) and must be padded.
7. Fuel tank may be relocated. If moved, it must be replaced by either a boat tank or a fuel cell and there must be a firewall between the driver and the tank. Tank may not be located in the driver's compartment. If the tank is moved the stock fuel tank must be removed from car.
8. All doors, hood and trunk (tailgate) must be chained shut. Hood and trunk maximum of 6 chains each. A maximum of 2 pieces of 5/8 (no tolerance) threaded rod may be used to hold down hood and 2 pieces of 5/8 (no tolerance) threaded rod for the trunk. Threaded rod may not stick up more than 1 1/2 inches from the surface and may not be used as reinforcement. Hood must have a 12-inch hole cut above the carburetor in case of fire. Hoods and trunks are subject to be open for inspection. If you choose not to open your trunk you must have a 12" square or circle opening in the middle for inspection purposes.
9. Only cars that came stock with an electric fuel pump may use an electric fuel pump. You must have a clearly marked toggle switch to cut off the fuel mounted on the dashboard within reach of the driver and safety crew.
10. Only one securely mounted battery per car. Battery must be mounted to the floor and be covered as to prevent acid spill.
11. No welding will be allowed except for the driver's door and stock bumper mounts. No welding or cutting of frame as to weaken or strengthen. No reinforcement of any kind or any trailer hitches will be allowed.
12. Maximum bumper height will be 24 inches.
13. Officials have the final decision on all matters relating to the rules and regulations.

Note: In the 6 Cylinder Demolition Derby the wheelbase must be a minimum of 100 inches and a maximum of 104 inches.
